

OTHER PERMITS

SWIMMING POOL PERMITS

PERMIT REQUIRED:

No person shall discharge or permit to be discharged any swimming pool water into the District System without first obtaining a permit and conforming to conditions of any such permit.

INSPECTIONS:

The District may inspect any facilities designed or utilized to allow Swimming Pool Discharge to enter the District System and the property owner shall be Responsible for payment of the Observation/Inspection Fees.

PERMIT FEES:

The person liable shall pay a swimming pool discharge permit fee in the amount of **\$150.00** at the time of application.

HYDRANT PERMITS

1. The only use for which water may be taken from fire protection facilities without a permit is for the fighting of fires.
2. Water to be used for purposes other than fighting fires, such as construction or temporary irrigation, may be withdrawn from fire hydrants only with the following authorizations:

SOUTHGATE'S HYDRANT USE PERMIT

Issued at Southgate for a charge of \$50 per quarter/per hydrant. A sample of this permit is on the next page.

DENVER WATER DEPARTMENT'S PERMIT

Issued at Denver Water arranging for measurement and charge for water taken from the hydrant. Call Denver Water (303/628-6100) for more information.

NOTE: REPORT ANY DEFECTS OF THE HYDRANT PRIOR TO USE.

The following constitutes the Conditions and Operating Rules for any hydrant in the Southgate Water District. Failure to abide by the following will be cause for permit revocation and Denver Water/Southgate fines.

RULES

- ONLY approved hydrant wrenches will be used on the operating nut. Contact: Dana Kepner at 303/623-6161, Ferguson Waterworks 720/859-3060 or HD Waterworks at 303/292-1112 if you do not have a wrench.
- Adequate equipment support is required. Refer to Denver Water "Standards for Hydrant Meter Installation."
- All fittings must be securely fastened to allow no leakage. A control valve MUST be used on any hydrant being used more than once a day.
- Turn hydrant in the direction of the arrow. Hydrants must be used in the FULL open position. Any regulation of flow MUST be accomplished by an external valve.
- Hydrant MUST be shut off completely, without using excessive force.
- A hydrant drains through weep holes at the bottom of the barrel section, BEFORE replacing cap visually check that the hydrant is draining properly.
- Replace all caps hand tight, then using a hydrant wrench continue 1/4 turn. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN!

CONDITIONS

- Employees of Southgate are authorized to ask for and examine this permit at any time. Hydrant tag MUST be attached to meter.
- Southgate reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time, without prior notice to applicant.
- Applicant agrees to make arrangements with the Denver Water Dept. for proper application and payment of water usage.
- Applicant agrees to REIMBURSE Southgate for any and all damages to the permitted hydrant caused by the applicant, his agents or employees.
- Applicant agrees to operate the hydrant according to the RULES and CONDITIONS herewithin.
- Applicant agrees to CONTACT Southgate WITHIN 24 HOURS of the permit date for the following: chains missing, operating nut is damaged, opens/closes with difficulty, or displays high/low pressure. FAILURE to CONTACT the District may result in assessment of damages.
- Applicant agrees to renew this permit if the hydrant is needed after the expiration date.

KEEP A COPY OF THIS PERMIT ON SITE OF THE HYDRANT LOCATION WHILE IN USE
